Tool and Material List

Tools necessary for the Weaving Workshop:

- ◆ 1 Medium Batten 18" long
- ◆ 1 Medium Weaving Comb, 1-1/2" wide
- ◆ 2 3/8" Dowels for shed, heddle stick, 36" long
- ◆ 1 clothesline rope (cotton)
- ◆ 4 skeins of wool (medium weight)
- ◆ 1 Navajo Style Loom
- ◆ Items listed under "Basic Lab Fee"

The above list can be provided by instructor in the "Combined Lab Fee" of \$95 or you may bring your own, except for the Basic Lab List. See below for the Basic Lab Fee if you have your own loom, tools and yarn. The Combined Lab Fee is a great bargain if you are traveling light. The weaving tools provided in the package are loaned to you for the duration of the workshop. Please check the appropriate box on your registration form.

Basic Lab Fee (Required for all beginning weavers): \$45

- ◆ Double Ply Warp
- ◆ Three Ply Side Edge Cord
- ◆ Raw Wool for Carding and Spinning
- ◆ Dye Plants and Mordant
- ◆ Weaving Handbook
- ◆ 1 sacking needle.

Loom Rental : \$30
